Reference: North Mesier Avenue Road Reconstruction Project Schedule

Dear Residents:

As you may be aware, the Village has received a grant from the New York State Department of Transportation to rebuild a section of North Mesier Avenue between East Main Street and a point just North of Trabucco Place.

The construction will commence the week of April 21st, 2014 with mobilization taking place that week. The installation of the underground sanitary sewer and water main will start the week of April 28th, 2014 and will continue through, including the week of July 21st, 2014.

After the underground utilities are complete, the excavation for curbs and sidewalks will start the week of July 28th, 2014. It is hoped that they will be complete by September 1st, 2014. At that point, the road will be prepped for paving which will take place the 2nd week of September 2014. After the road is paved, the space between the curbs and sidewalks will be topsoiled and seeded, new trees will be planted, and traffic signs will be put in place. That should take us through the third week in September 2014.

The contractor has allowed three weeks for punchlist cleanup and demobilization work ending the project the third week of October 2014.


Obviously, the above schedule is predicated on good weather and encountering no unforeseen circumstances.

There will be inconveniences during this construction due to these activities. It is requested that if you have any questions, please contact Village Hall at 297-8773 and the appropriate person will be assigned to whatever issue has arisen.

Again, we ask for your patience during this construction process and will work with the residents during this period to assure the completion of the project with minimal amount of disturbance.
