**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**LOCAL LAW NO. 6 FOR THE YEAR 2014**

A Local Law entitled Local Law No.6 for the year 2014, amending the parking rules along Franklindale Avenue in the Village of Wappingers Falls.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wappingers Falls, as follows:

**SECTION 1: LEGISLATIVE INTENT**

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Wappingers Falls has deemed it necessary to amend section 143-62 of the Code of the Village of Wappingers Falls so as to create a no parking zone along a certain section of the north side of Franklindale Avenue.

**SECTION 2: TEXT**

Section 143-62 of the Code of the Village of Wappingers Falls is hereby amended so as to add the following:

**SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY**

If any provision of this chapter or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not effect or impair the validity of the other provisions of the chapter or the application thereof to other person's circumstances.

**SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
